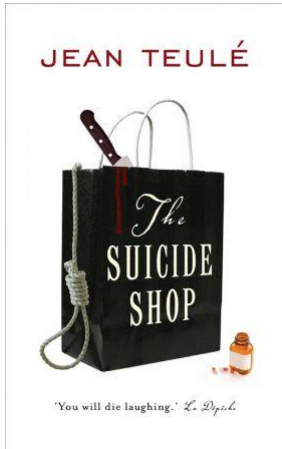


The Suicide Shop
